



Internet Acceptable Use Policy 2011-2012

The Internet is an invaluable resource to teachers and students that can provide information and enhance the classroom curriculum. We will be discussing Internet safety rules in Computer class. Seton School uses filtering software that significantly reduces the chances of exposure to anything inappropriate through the Internet. However, this is not a total guarantee. The students are supervised closely while using the Internet, and only will be allowed to go to web addresses that connect with the subject curriculum. By using these guidelines and the filtering software, the students will have the benefit of reinforcement of classroom material and learning additional, up-to-date information on a subject matter. Students will not have email access.

Please read the following guidelines. **Students and parents must sign and return the bottom portion of this form as soon as possible** to allow the students to use the Internet in classroom-related activities

Internet Safety Guidelines

1. Students may use the Internet only with permission from the teacher.
2. Students may access only teacher specified web sites.
3. Students may not access personal email, facebook, or instant messaging.
4. Students may not give out any personal information, such as names, addresses, telephone numbers, school name, passwords, etc.
5. Students will notify a teacher immediately if they see any information that is inappropriate.
6. Students may not download files from the Internet.
7. Students must observe and comply with copyright laws.
8. Failure to follow school Internet policies will result in Internet privileges being revoked.
