Box Tops

Box Tops for Education is a simple fundraising program that allows schools to earn cash simply by having supporters clip the "Box Tops for Education" symbol on participating products and turning them into the school. Each Box Top is worth ten cents. We collect these from families and school supporters (aunts, uncles, grandparents, neighbors) and count and mail them in. Seton then receives a check in the mail. It's that simple. We often raise about \$3000 a year. We urge everyone to participate by saving and you can sign up to help count as well.

SCRIP

SCRIP is a program that earns money for Seton School with no extra cost to you. Simply purchase gift certificates from over 150 local and national retailers and a percentage of the sale is returned to Seton by the retailers. SCRIP forms are sent home with the youngest child in each family every other week. Return your order and the certificates will be forwarded to you two days later. We also sell SCRIP that we have on hand on a walk-in basis at the Middle School office.
