We are now into the 2nd week of the 4th quarter of school. In just two short months your child will be a 4th grader!

We are finishing the chapter on Statistics and Probability in math and will be moving on to measurement and time. We are working on multiplication in the Mastering Math Facts program. I would recommend continuing to practice multiplication facts all summer long so that your child does not forget them and is ready for 4th grade math.

I will only be sending home one more book order before the end of the school year. Around mid April I will send the April and May orders home together. This will be a good opportunity to stock up on summer reading material. It's unbelievable to me that the end of the school year is just around the corner☺

In science, we are finishing the chapter on the Solar System. We will end the year studying about minerals and rocks. We are finishing Chapter 6 in social studies- Our Country's History and will be moving on to Citizenship in Chapter 7. We are also finishing up Unit 6 in English- pronouns. Once we are done, we will be concentrating on how all the parts of speech work together in our writing.

I sent a note home on Thursday, March 24th about a biography book report. The book report will be written at home because it will be set up as a mystery person report. The book report is due Thursday, April 14th. Students will present the report to the class and see if anyone can guess the person they have written about. I will give the students a 12" by 18" sheet of construction paper when they are ready to write their report.
