Dear Parents,

Thank you for all of the great donations to our "QC Dining" basket and to everyone who will be volunteering to help with the spaghetti dinner this Friday. It looks like the spaghetti dinner will be a success once again this year.

As the year rolls along, please make sure to ask your child if he/she has enough pencils, erasers, crayons, glue sticks, and markers at school. At this point we still have plenty of tissues, paper towels, and wipes.

Please continue to check your child's take home folders every night. Occasionally your child may bring unfinished work home for homework. This work is due the next school day. Our next book report will be on Thursday, February 10th. The students are doing a good job of signing up early for the books they will be reading. We are still reading fiction stories. Our last book report will be in April. At that time the students will be reading a biography. The biography book report will be written at home. There will be a Valentine's Day party in the afternoon on Monday, February 14th. More information will be sent home about the party soon. Attached is a class list. Please make sure you have a Valentine for all 16 students.
